Call to help us reduce our carbon footprint by 2040

MTN has committed to achieve net zero emissions by 2040. This is part of our **Ambition 2025 strategy: leading digital solutions for Africa's progress** which includes creating shared value, with ESG at the core.

With global warming impacting countries, communities and people everywhere, we have set ourselves science-based targets aligned to the Paris Agreement. They aim to achieve, by 2030, a 47% average reduction in MTN's absolute scope 1,2 and 3 emissions (tCO₂e).

As nearly half of MTN's energy use and associated greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions are Scope 3 emissions from our supply chain, we can only achieve our goal by collaborating closely with our suppliers. We therefore call on you, our valued supply chain partners, to pledge your commitment and work alongside us by:

1. Setting a science-based carbon-reduction target for your organisation and publicly communicating your commitment.
2. Reporting your progress on reducing carbon emission using the CDP system and then sharing your emissions data with us – both at a services and product level.
3. Embedding GHG emission reductions at both a product development and service delivery level.
4. Ensuring your own suppliers are aware of this call to action, so that it can then be cascaded through your business's supply chain, actively building the capacity of local suppliers in the process.
5. Supporting the ECO rating of each device, and actively supporting our activities to provide life cycle product service to customers including trade-ins and recycling options.

At MTN we believe in the power of partnerships. We thank you in advance for taking these vital steps towards creating a more sustainable planet with us and look forward to realising a net zero future together.
